#### WELCOME



# STORYLAB Young Writers DevelopmentProgram

YWDP gives young writers, aged 8-14, tips on perfecting style, editing work and improving the flow of a story to help them push through the middle and late stages of writing a story and making it through to the end.

Over the course of the year three groups of talented young writers received support and mentoring from award winning author, Deb Fitzpatrick. At the end of each program the writers' work was published as a collection of short stories.

In response to COVID-19 we piloted a Young Writers Mentorship Program aimed at writers aged 13-16.

This small group program ran over 7 weeks as online interactive discussion-based sessions to talk in depth about elements of the craft of writing.

Each session had a different theme, including; Getting started - Creating authentic characters - Getting the best out of dialogue - Telling story through setting - The narrative arc - Editing your work - Entering competitions
